## **A Note From Pastor Doug...**

### **New Year's Resolutions**

As the year turns, many of us begin to contemplate making New Year's resolutions as a way to make a change in our lives. There are many reasons that we do so. We perhaps have seen something in our lives that we think needs change. Or maybe we want to try something new, something different, to shake things up. Sometimes New Year's resolutions may simply be putting into a regular practice something that we are already doing, something that we've tried and know that is helpful in our lives.

Whatever our reasons, the simple fact remains that most New Year's resolutions are abandoned at some point after the new year begins. According to one statistical source, 75% of resolutions are maintained through one week, 71% make it through two weeks, 64% make it through January, and by six months in, it drops to under half, to about 46%. Less than half of our resolutions make it through six months, let alone through the whole year.

Such statistics might make one wonder why to make any resolutions at all. Even though more than half of resolutions make it less than six months, making the attempt at least gives one the opportunity to make changes, to try new things, to give it a go. Much like other ventures, giving it a go has a far better success rate than never trying! Also, another key to making changes in our lives is to share our commitments with someone else, and to check in regularly to see how its going. Accountability such as this will make you more likely to follow through on resolutions.

Will you be making a commitment, a new resolution about your faith this year? I'd like to suggest some options if you are interested in making a new commitment around your faith life for this coming year. You might commit to reading the Bible on a daily basis. Or perhaps committing to a new devotional practice on a regular basis. I would also like to suggest that we commit to sharing our faith on a regular basis, to invite others to join with us in worship. If you do make a New Year's resolution around your faith for this coming year, I would invite you to find someone in the congregation with whom you share that commitment. In doing so, perhaps you will be able to better keep to your resolution.
