Camp Bethel: Doing Important Work since 1927

This month marks the beginning of Camp Bethel's annual summer camping program, beginning on June 12. Well, at least the first campers are going to be coming on June 12. The summer staff will have been undergoing an intensive training program for two weeks prior. In fact, as you are reading this article, summer staff training has already begun for this year. As has been my practice, I will be spending a week serving as chaplain for the summer camp program, which will be June 12-17 this year.

Camp Bethel has been an important part of district work in our area since before the formation of our current Virgina District, with the founding of Camp Bethel stretching back to 1927. As you may or may not know, the current location was not the first place Brethren attempted a camping program in the area. Prior to the purchase of the first part of Camp Bethel's property, attempts were made on top of Tinker Mountain which proved difficult due to lack of water. In fact, the very reason that Camp Bethel is located where it is comes because of the need for an easy supply of water.

Why, we may wonder, is the ministry that occurs at Camp Bethel important? What is it about outdoor ministries that makes it an important part of the wider ministry of the church? The work of outdoor ministries at Camp Bethel offers the opportunity for children, youth, young adults, and even older adults to benefit from the experience of Christian community and immersion in a natural setting.

Through this important work, many who might not have any other exposure to the teachings of the church have the opportunity to experience a little bit of what it means to live together in Christian community. They get a chance to experience the beauty of God's creation through a deep immersion in the natural wonders of Camp Bethel.

On Father's Day, June 19, we will be having our outdoor worship at Camp Bethel. This offers all of us the opportunity to spend time at the camp. As we gather together that morning, we too will experience a little bit of the great joy and work that goes into the ministries of Camp Bethel. I would invite all of us to be sure to make it to this wonderful time together at camp.
